Minimum Graduation Credit Requirement : 138 Credits ( including Required courses 44 credits, Required Elective courses 16 credits )

Specific Regulations :

1. Students are to complete and pass 「 Graduation Requirements for Foreign Languages Proficiency 」 (noncredit) course before graduation.
2. Course credits obtained outside the department of Japanese can be counted as graduation credits.
3. A maximum of FOUR (4) Elective Military Discipline credits can be counted as graduation credits.
4. Elective Physical Education credits can be counted as graduation credits.
